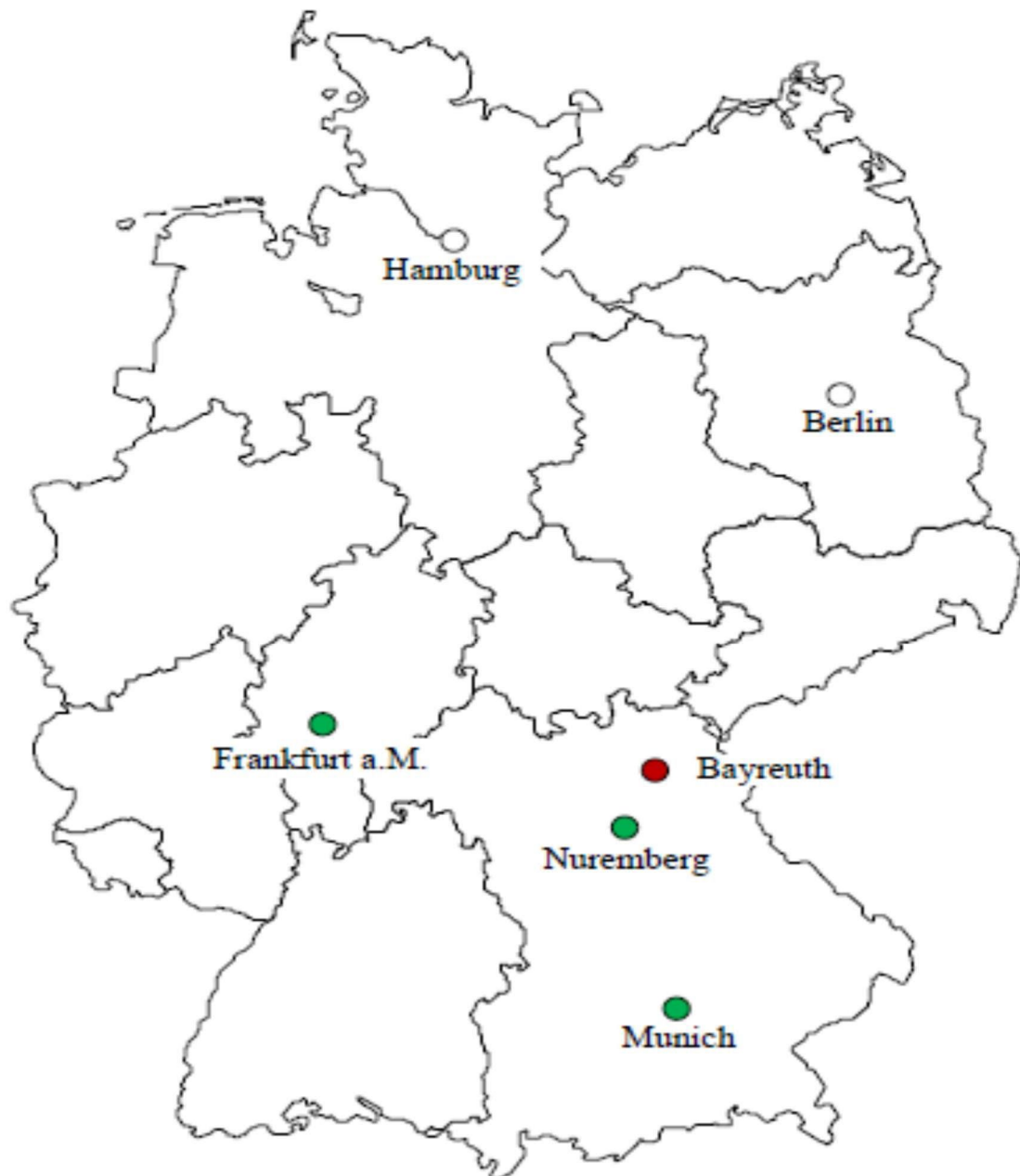

## AIRPLANE

International guests will find that a flight to Nuremberg will be most convenient as it is the closest airport to Bayreuth. Bayreuth is almost equidistant from the Munich and Frankfurt a.M. airports.



# RAILWAY

The journey from the airport to Bayreuth will require you to take a train.

## FROM NUREMBERG TO BAYREUTH

Once you reach the Nuremberg Airport, you can proceed to the central train station by taking the metro. The line **U2** to “**Nürnberg Hbf (Hauptbahnhof)**” (German for “Nuremberg central train station”) is the train that you need to board. At the “Nürnberg Hauptbahnhof” station, you will have to disembark and take a regional express train (RE) from here to Bayreuth. This last train ride will approximately take between 1 and 1.5 hours. You will have to leave the train at “**Bayreuth Hauptbahnhof**” station, which is the main train station in Bayreuth and the only stop in Bayreuth.

Note, that the German word “Hauptbahnhof” sometimes is abbreviated by “HBF”.

## FROM MUNICH TO BAYREUTH

Once you reach the Munich Airport, you will have to take the train to “**München Hauptbahnhof**” (central train station). From there, you will be able to take another train connection that directly brings you to “**Nürnberg Hauptbahnhof**” (central train station in Nuremberg). It will take you between 1 and 1.5 hours to get to Nuremberg from the main train station in Munich. Once in Nuremberg, you can proceed to Bayreuth by following the steps described under “From Nuremberg to Bayreuth”.

## FROM FRANKFURT TO BAYREUTH

Once you reach the Frankfurt a.M. Airport, you need to take the train to get to “**Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof**” (central train station Frankfurt), from where you can catch a direct train to Nuremberg. Depending on the train, it will take you approximately 2 – 2.5 hours to get to “**Nürnberg Hauptbahnhof**” (central train station in Nuremberg). Some trains directly go from “Frankfurt a.M. Airport” to “Nürnberg Hauptbahnhof”. Once in Nuremberg, you can proceed to Bayreuth by following the steps described under “From Nuremberg to Bayreuth”.

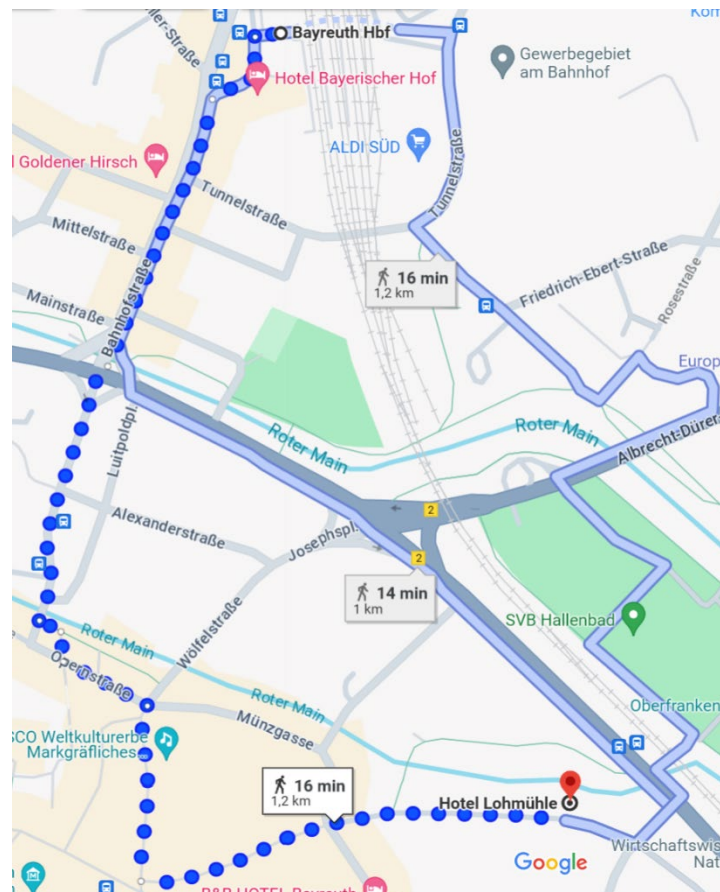
## TO THE HOTEL “LOHMÜHLE”

### BY CAR

Leave the motorway A9 (Munich-Berlin) at exit 42 “Bayreuth Süd”, turn right onto B2 and right onto Nürnberger Straße, after 1,6 km turn right onto Hohenzollernring. Keep left and after 500 meters turn left onto Romanstraße and immediately right onto Badstraße. You will find the hotel on the right side.

### BY FOOT

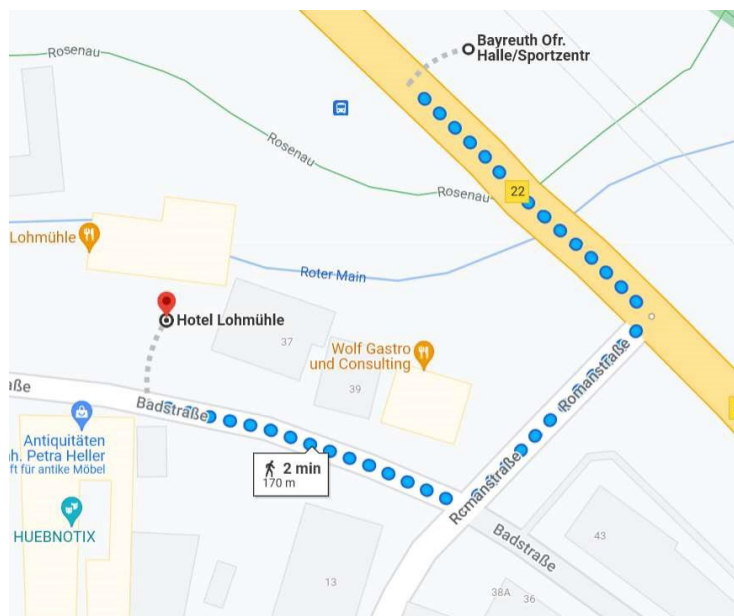
Distances are very short in Bayreuth. It takes less than 20 minutes to walk from the train station to the hotel “Lohmühle”. You can simply follow the dotted blue line on the map below for walking to the hotel.



## BY BUS

To get to the hotel “Lohmühle” by bus you can use the bus stop in front of the central train station. You can use the busses number **302** (direction: Z O H - St. Johannis (Eremitage)) or **316** (direction: Campus) and exit the bus at Oberfrankenhalle/Sportzentrum. After exiting the bus turn right into the Romanstraße and then immediately right again into the Badstraße. The hotel will be on the right-hand side.

## BY CAB

Usually, there are many cabs available in front of the central train station. Please ask the driver to drop you off at the hotel “Lohmühle”. The address is: Badstraße 37, 95444 Bayreuth.

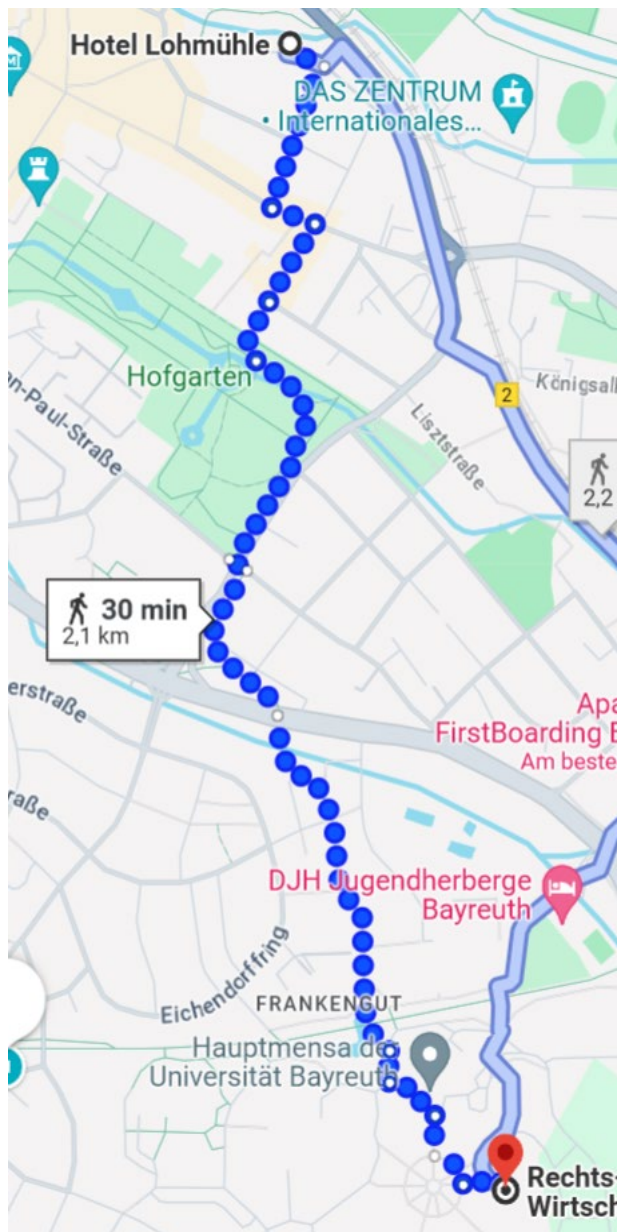


## FROM THE HOTEL “LOHMÜHLE” TO THE VENUE

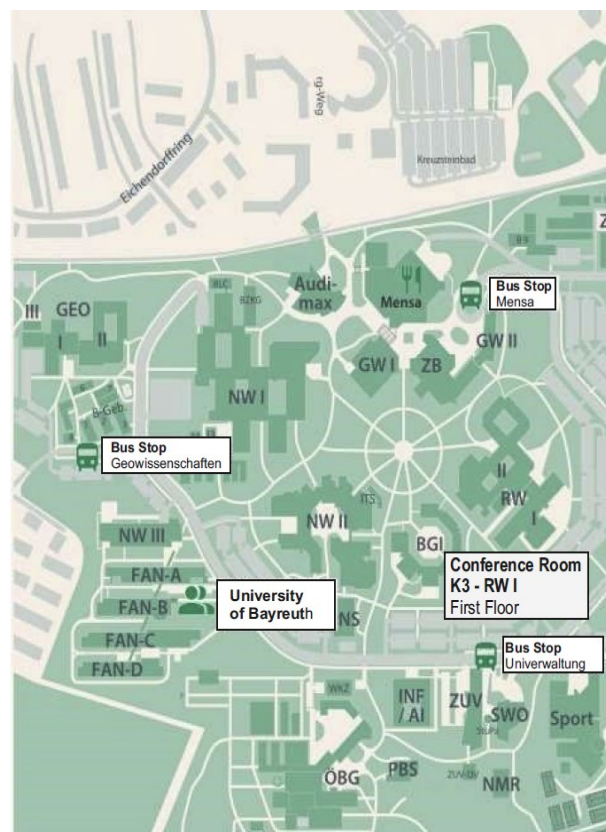
Distances in Bayreuth are very short. You can decide whether to walk to the venue or take the bus or a cab. The workshop will take place in the RW I building at the Faculty of Law, Business Administration and Economics (Rechts- und Wirtschaftswissenschaftliche Fakultät) at the campus of the University of Bayreuth.

### BY FOOT

It takes around 30 minutes to walk to the Faculty of Law, Business Administration and Economics. On the map below you can see the way to the University of Bayreuth. First, you need to head east on Badstraße towards Romanstraße, turn right onto Romanstraße and follow it for 230m.



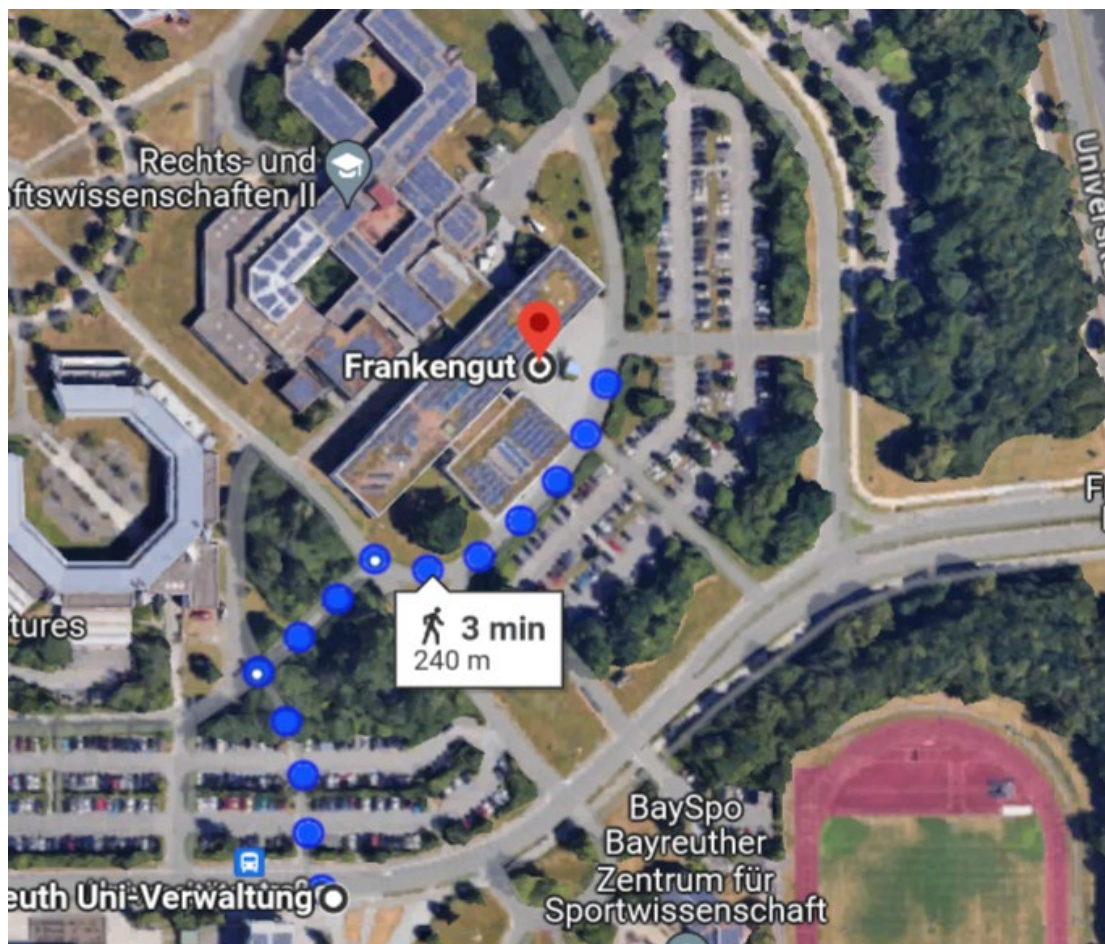
Afterwards, turn left onto Richard-Wagner-Straße. After the Richard Wagner-museum turn right onto Wahnfriedstraße and continue onto Hans-Rollwagen-Weg for 100m. After that, you have to go slight left toward Jean-Paul-Straße and follow it for 350m. Then turn left onto Jean-Paul-Straße, change street side and turn right towards Emil-Warburg-Weg. After changing the street side follow the description and dotted blue line on map. Once you reach the Faculty of Law, Business Administration and Economics, follow the signs to room K3 in RW I, which is on the first floor.



## BY BUS

There is a bus stop near the hotel. First, head east on Badstraße towards Romanstraße. Afterwards, turn left and you will see the bus stop “Oberfrankenhalle/Sportzentrum” on the left street sight next to the traffic lights. You can use the bus line **304** (direction: Birken - Universität) and exit at the station “Uni Verwaltung”. Once you reach the bus stop please follow the map below. Inside the RW I building, follow the signs to conference room K3 on the first floor.

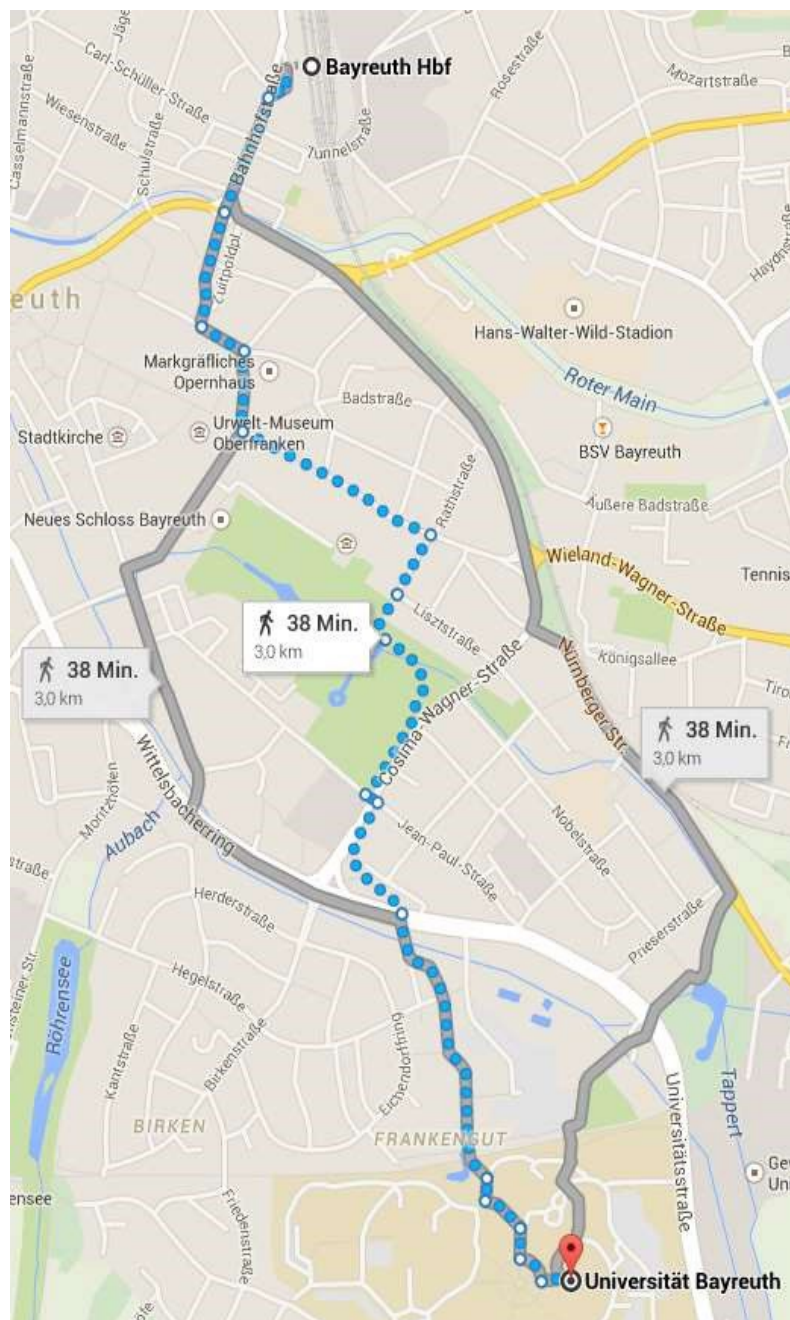
## BY CAB

If you decide to use a cab to go to the venue it will cost approximately 10€. Ask the driver to drop you off at the “RW I building at the Faculty of Law, Business Administration and Economics”. In German: “RW I Gebäude der Fakultät für Rechts- und Wirtschaftswissenschaften der Universität Bayreuth”. That is the building where you will find the conference room K3 on the first floor where our workshop will take place. The economics department and the Chair of International Macroeconomics are also located at the RW I building.

# FROM BAYREUTH TRAIN STATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF BAYREUTH

## BY FOOT

Distances in Bayreuth are short, and from the train station to the University it takes less than 40 minutes by foot. The dotted blue line on the map below shows the direction to the university.



## BY BUS

There is a bus route from the train station to the University. The bus stop is right in front of the train station. Depending on the route you choose, you will need to change the bus line once to get to the University.

First, you take bus line **328** (direction: Bayreuth ZOH-Klinik) or **309** (direction: Meyernberg Süd) to ZOH, Bayreuth. This first bus ride will take about 5 minutes. Then, at the station “ZOH” (Abbreviation for “Zentrale Omnibus Haltestelle”), you change lines and take the bus line **304** (direction: Birken - Universität) or **306** (direction: Campus). You can leave the bus at the station “Uni Verwaltung”, which is located near the RW I building where our workshop is located.

If you don't want to change busses, you can take the bus **316** (direction: Campus) and exit at “Uni Verwaltung”.

## BY CAB

Usually, there are cabs available right in front of the train station as well. If you would like to take a cab, the fare will be approximately 10 €. Ask the driver to drop you off at “RW I building at the Faculty of Law, Business Administration and Economics”. In German: “RW I Gebäude der Fakultät für Rechts- und Wirtschaftswissenschaften der Universität Bayreuth”. That is the building where you will find the conference room K3 on the first floor where our workshop will take place. The economics department and the Chair of International Macroeconomics are located at the RW I building.
